## **MU Postdoc Award & Grant Opportunities**

- MU Postdoctoral Awards for Teaching and Research
  - Nominees for these awards must currently be postdoctoral fellows at the University of Missouri, Columbia campus and have held the position as a postdoc for at least one semester prior to the nomination. Self-nominations are encouraged.
  - Postdoctoral award winners will be recognized at the Awards Banquet hosted by the Graduate School in April. The awards will consist of an honorarium of \$500 to \$1,000 (depending on the number of awardees). The awards will be administered by the MU Postdoctoral Association (MUPA) with support from the Office of Postdoctoral Education. Funding for the award is provided by the Graduate School.

- MU Postdoctoral Research Grant
  - The grant awards help defray the costs of conducting a clearly defined research project that is not financially supported by other grants, faculty members, or their department/division. The research project should be led by the postdoctoral scholar and represent a contribution to their independent research program.

- MU Postdoctoral Association Travel Awards
  - Postdocs may receive up to \$300 towards costs (limited to registration fees, lodging, poster printing, and childcare) for any Meeting/Conference and/or training program taking place from January 1st, 2023 to April 30th, 2023.

- Intelligence Community Postdoctoral Research Fellowship Program

#### **Tax Filing Season is here!**

Most individuals who earned income in 2022 are required to file 2022 tax returns. For non-U.S. citizens, the primary issue is knowing your tax residency as either a U.S. tax resident or a nonresident taxpayer. If you do not know your tax residency for 2022, let Nonresident Tax, HR/Payroll Operations know at munrataxoffice@missouri.edu and they will assist you.

### 1. If you are a U.S. tax resident, here are some resources:

a. IRS Free-file: https://www.irs.gov/filing/free-file-do-your-federal-taxes-for-free

b. The Office for Financial Success will have a VITA site starting February 15 – April 15 (162 Stanley Hall). Their services are offered by appointment only (schedule via MU Connect). If you don't have access to MU Connect, you can send an email request to financialsuccess@missouri.edu. There is an "open to the public" site (<u>https://extension.missouri.edu/programs/mu-family-impact-center/mu-fic-financial-legal-programs</u>) held at the MU Family Impact Center. They are walk-in, first-come, first-served. There are other VITA sites open to the public in Columbia not related to MU as well.

### 2. If you are a nonresident taxpayer, please see the information below.

**a. University of Missouri - Columbia** has arranged **free access** to **Sprintax** for you. Sprintax will guide you through the tax preparation process, arrange the necessary documents and check if you're due a tax refund.



Once you complete the preparation process in the Sprintax software, you may need to print, sign and mail your documents to the IRS. Depending on your circumstances, you may be able to E-file your Federal tax return. However, this will depend on certain eligibility criteria. You can learn more about eligibility in this Sprintax blog

If you have a state filing requirement, you must also mail this to the tax authorities. Finally, if you only need to file Form 8843, this will also need to be mailed to the IRS. If you have any
