## Application to waive the one-semester MU residency requirement

The one-semester residency requirement is designed so that an international student can adjust to the differences presented by U.S. academic life and culture. In addition, the international student will be able to observe how teaching at MU differs from teaching in their home country.

ITAP can request a waiver from the Chancellor or their designee on behalf of an international teaching assistant. Under the law, the Chancellor may only grant a waiver for the residency requirement, not for the language assessment and training requirement. Waivers are not automatically granted. They are given only under the following conditions:

- 1. The international student received a language assessment and has strong language skills for the type of teaching assignment they are receiving,
- 2. The international student attended the Graduate Teaching Orientation (GTO) prior to the beginning of the semester he/she is to begin teaching, and
- 3. The international student has demonstrated familiarity with the culture of the American university classroom.

If you feel an incoming international student warrants a waiver, please fill out the following application and return it to the ITAP office at least two weeks prior to the semester the waiver is needed.
