- ProQuest TDM
  - The library has a trial of ProQuest TDM is available through September 15.
  - To get started, you will need to create a TDM Studio account.
    - Go to https://tdmstudio.proquest.com
    - Click "Create Account" button in the upper right
    - Use your MU email address to create your account
    - Select University of Missouri Columbia from the drop-down list
      - Note: If you have an existing ProQuest account, you will be prompted to use it for login.
    - Click on the workbench and data visualization icon once you are logged in.
  - Once your account is created, ProQuest will send you a welcome email with a link to schedule a 1:1 technical onboarding meeting. This will be a great opportunity for you to discuss your project and how best to utilize the trial period to gather the data you need, as well as learn the functions to get started using TDM Studio.
