 - Deadline: Jan 14, 2025
- [Misophonia Research Fund \(MRF\)](#)
 - The Misophonia Research Fund (MRF) current RFPs solicit research proposals seeking to better understand misophonia, characterize symptomatology and associated impairments, develop and validate diagnostics, and assess interventional strategies to treat those with the disorder. The MRF is now accepting letters of intent/proposals for the 2025 funding cycle for two award mechanisms:
 - Misophonia Research Impact Award
 - Up to \$500,000 in total funding support for research projects led by independent investigators
 - Up to \$200,000 in total funding for postdoctoral applicants
 - LOI submission deadline: Fri, Dec 6, 2024
 - Invited full proposals due on Fri, Mar 7, 2025
 - Misophonia Data Discovery Award
 - Independent investigators, postdocs, and graduate-level students are encouraged to apply for this grant opportunity that provides up to \$75,000 in total funding in support of innovative research projects to acquire initial datasets to seed larger projects.
 - Full proposal submission deadline: Mon, Jan 6, 2025
