4. Committee Reports:
 - a. **Academic Affairs Committee – Prof. Julie Miller, Chair**
 - i. New program presentations
 - New program Graduate Certificate in Decision and Operations Analytics, Industrial and Systems Engineering, presented by Dr Suchi Rajendran.
 - AI-integrated decision science, not just handling data
 - 12 cr hr, open to degree- and non-degree-seeking students, already existing courses
 - Market is grad students in industrial engr, data science, computer science, transportation engr, and related STEM fields, and also working professionals seeking this sort of training.
 - Addresses Missouri workforce needs, no duplication at MU or UM System, strong industry advisory input.
 - How does someone in industry fulfill requirement? Right now

we have in-person to start off and then down the line plan to offer online as curriculum is revised and expanded.

- Might be beneficial to cross-network with other machine-learning researchers.
- Easy to swap out requirements to stack this program onto existing degree requirements.

c. **Policy Committee – Prof. Rocio Rivera, Chair**

- i. Paid Sick Leave policy: Policy change suggestion – see language in Canvas
 - i. Task was to clarify whether 10 days was 10 days total or 10 days at an individual stretch. 10 working days = 40 working hours for 0.5FTE assistantship.
 - ii. Should policy apply just to students in assistantships? Or to hourly students? Or to all enrolled students? We do have the ability to extend insurance through a COBRA-like process even if students are not enrolled. There are also policies for missing courses, etc. at the faculty council level, so conflating the policies is problematic. Coursework is handled separately from employee stuff.
 - iii. Remove coursework and research language, add 40 working hours for a 0.5FTE assistantship with proration language, add language regarding funding agency leave policy (from pregnant/parenting policy).
- ii. Course Credits and Graduate Credentials – see language in Canvas
 - i. Can only use for 2 credentials (Masters, Specialist, Doctoral), or a 3rd if the 3rd credential is a GCert or a GMinor.
 - ii. Policy to go back to units for additional context/feedback then vote next time.

- a. No committee reports because they hadn't met for this semester yet. Only lost \$9M in Athletics this year. Spent \$181M dollars, made \$172M dollars.

7. Report: Graduate School – **Dean Jeni Hart**

- a. We are encouraging people to continue to admit people because we don't know if international students are actually already in the USA. But yes, make informed decisions and maybe have a longer waitlist.

Big Beautiful Bill – people who have GradPlus loans will continue to get GradPlus loans for duration of program or 3 years whichever comes first, however part-time students can no longer get full-time loans. Office of Financial Aid is going to talk to GADs and DGSs to do some additional education because new rules go into effect July 1.
